ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Teach up to four lower-division Spanish language courses per semester for the 2009-2010 academic year at the ASU Downtown Phoenix Campus.

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

Masters' Degree in Spanish linguistics or related field; near or near-native proficiency in Spanish; a minimum of two years of relevant university-level post secondary teaching experience; experience with the integration of computer technology into classroom instruction; evidence of excellent teaching ability. Applicants who are not native speakers of English must provide evidence of having received a minimum score of 55 on either the SPEAK test or the TSE.

DESIRED

Experience in curriculum design and the creation of instructional and assessment materials to teach Spanish at the post-secondary level; experience teaching and creating materials for Spanish courses for the professions (e.g., medicine, social work, education); experience teaching Spanish courses for heritage learners; evidence of professional development activities.
